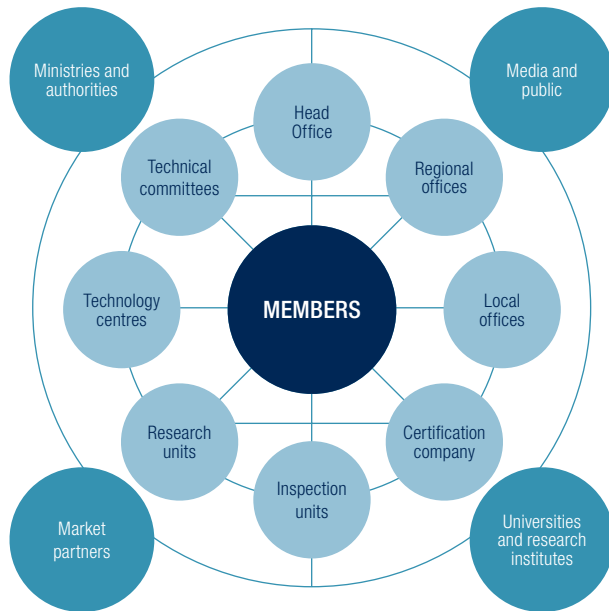


## Organization – competence and member orientation

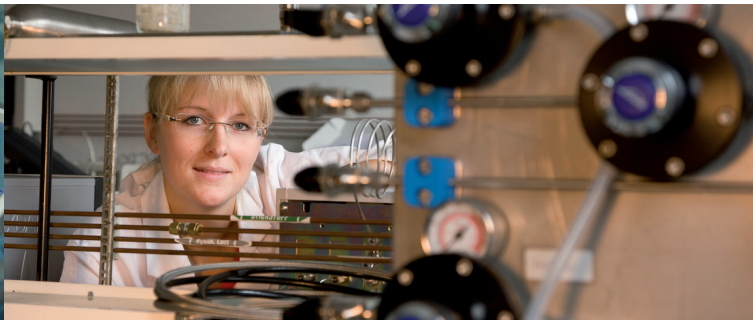

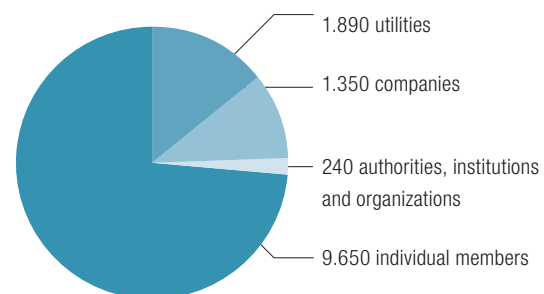
